

. . a Persian mathematician, astronomer and geographer of the Umayyad period, who, with his son ‘Abd al-Quddūs Mas‘ūdī, produced the earliest surviving arithmetic books, the Kitāb al-Maghāzī ("Book of Arithmetic") and Kitāb al-Aghānī ("Book of Geography"). The latter work, as well as an older manuscript of the former, containing an arithmetic treatise in nine books by Mas‘ūdī's father and grandfather, and one by his uncle, have survived in the Bibliothèque Nationale in Paris. Life Mas‘ūdī was born in Baghdad, the son of Abū al-Ḥasan ‘Alī ibn al-Ḥusayn ibn Mas‘ūd ibn Sulaymān ibn ‘Abd al-Malik ibn Zayd ibn Sulaymān ibn ‘Abd Allāh ibn Abī Ṭālib ibn ‘Abd al-Malik ibn Abī al-Ḥasan al-Bayḍāwī. . . . He is also claimed by some to have been the father of the Islamic philosopher/mathematician Muhammad ibn Mūsā al-Khwārizmī (sometimes referred to as the Copernicus of Islam). Mas‘ūdī was one of the pioneers of the development of algebraic notation in the Arab world. His work in this field can be found in his "Algebra," and "A Treatise on the Calculation of the Mean and the Abū-Faṭḥ-Hirah." The work "The Algebra of the Almaghest Mas‘ud" has survived in a manuscript in the Bibliothèque Nationale in Paris. Mas‘ūdī is also claimed to have been the author of a work on spherical trigonometry. The Kitāb al-Maghāzī ("Book of Arithmetic") is one of the earliest extant mathematical texts, dealing with arithmetic and algebraic notation. It was compiled by Mas‘ūdī and his son, and is in 9 books, divided into groups of four sub-sections each. Each sub-section contains calculations on the mean, with three tables for each.
